

3. Games

- 3.1 If a complete team fails to report to a match 10 minutes before scheduled time, the team will forfeit the game.
- 3.2 Each match shall consist of one innings per team.
- 3.3 Each innings shall consist of a maximum of five 6-ball overs
- 3.4 Each outfield player may bowl no more than 1 over. In the case of a bowler becoming incapacitated, a bowler who has previously bowled may be elected by the opposition Captain to bowl a 2nd over or complete any outstanding balls if the injured player was bowling at the time of becoming incapacitated.
- 3.5 The wicket keeper may not bowl.
- 3.6 2 batsmen shall be at the wicket at all times during an innings. In the event of a team losing 5 wickets within the permitted 5 overs, the last man shall continue batting with the fifth man out, remaining at the wicket as a runner.

4. Winners

- 4.1 In a match, the team that has scored the most number of runs will be declared a winner.
- 4.2 If both the teams have scored the same number of runs in the allocated number of overs, then the side which has lost the lesser number of wickets will be declared the winner.
- 4.3 If both the teams are still tied, then the spin of a coin will decide the winner.
- 4.4 If the match is abandoned for any reason (like bad weather, etc) and the side batting second has not had the chance of batting for at least two overs, then the winner will be decided by the spin of coin.
- 4.5 In cases where the match is tied based on the aggregate runs, the winner will be team which has lost the lesser number of wickets. If the match is still tied, then the winner will be decided by the spin of a coin.
- 4.6 The overall winners will receive a trophy.

5. No balls and Wides

- 5.1 Wides will count as 2 runs with no extra ball other than in the last over of a game. No balls will be called in accordance with the normal rules of Cricket.
- 5.2 Negative or short-pitched bowling is not in the spirit of the competition and will be penalised as 2 runs a ball

6-a-Side Fun Cricket Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Tournament

1.1 The 'Tournament' of 12 teams will be played at St Georges Cricket Club. This is primarily a “fun” competition to raise funds for our cricket club. We hope teams will enter into the spirit of the day whilst being competitive.

1.2 Every team will play at least 3 games. The games will be comprised of 5 overs per side.

1.3 An entry fee of £60 is payable by every team. Cheques made payable to “St Georges Cricket Club”. Monies to be paid by 30 June 2019 (if the Tournament is cancelled beforehand due to inclement weather a refund will be given).

1.4 A registration form stating the names players will be required by 9:30 a.m. on the morning of the Competition.

1.5 The tournament will be governed by the tournament committee who shall be the sole judge to decide on any matters that require arbitration and their decision will be final.

1.6 The tournament shall start at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday 25th August, 2019. Participating teams must be at the ground by 9:30 a.m..

2. Teams

2.1 There will be a maximum of 12 teams based on first come first served basis.

2.2 Each Team will be made up of six of their squad players. Each team shall nominate a Captain who would be responsible for tossing and setting the field during a match. The captain shall also be responsible for good conduct and for compliance to the rules of the tournament.

2.3 Each team shall nominate a wicket-keeper, who will not bowl.

2.4 While a match is in progress, the teams that are scheduled to play next shall toss and get ready to play the next match. To ensure continuous play throughout the day one of the teams from the following match will pad up and be ready to start their game as soon as the previous game is finished. .

2.5 While playing a match or otherwise, if a team is not able to complete the allotted number of overs either during batting or bowling, the team shall be considered to have forfeited the game.
